Planning For Our Future...

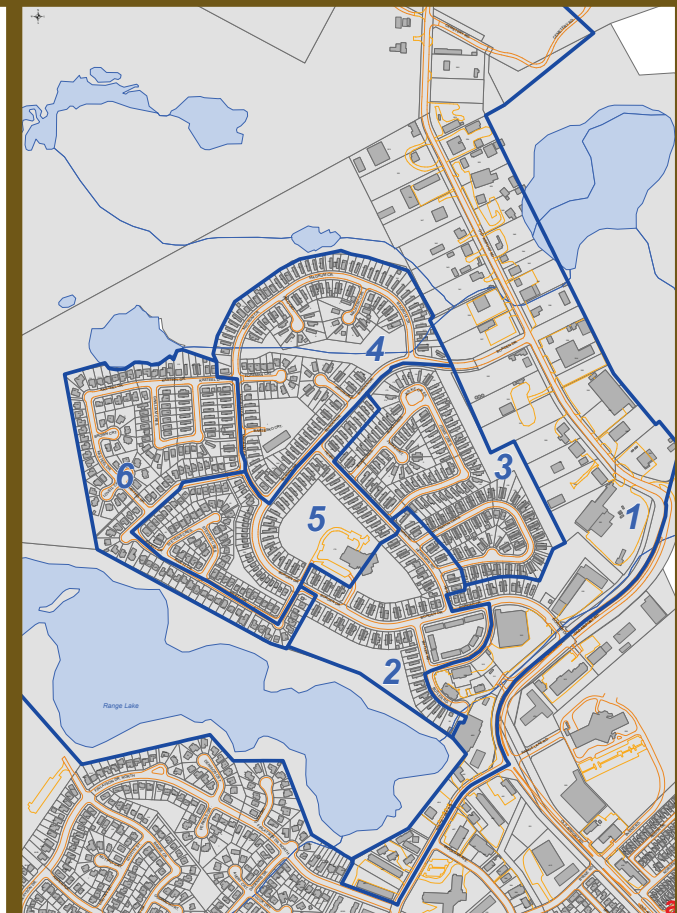
- Rather than just developing strategies and action items, develop concrete plans for the future of our territory and make them happen.
